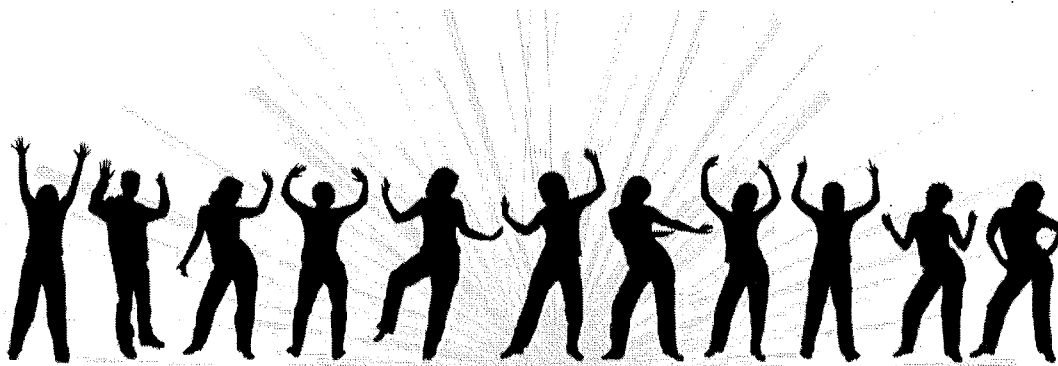

When: Monday, October 31th at **2:00 PM** for the **Anti-Bullying 1 Mile RUN/WALK** and approximately **2:30 PM** for the **PUMPKIN DROP (no volunteers needed)**

October is **ANTI-BULLYING** month and we will be empowering our students to respond to bullying in a safe and effective manner. We are going to celebrate what we learned about standing up to bullying by having a 1 mile Run/Walk at the end of October in conjunction with our PUMPKIN DROP festivities. Dr. Gadson, our district's Curriculum Division leader, will be our guest speaker. Superintendent Jenkins, Mayor Shep Harris, and a few school board members will also be attending this event. The **PUMPKIN DROP** - is an engineering design project in which each classroom gets to design a capsule to hold their pumpkin. The goal is to design a functional capsule (container) that will be able to hold the pumpkin and keep it from breaking apart when dropped from the roof at SEA.

ALL FAMILIES are invited to come join us in walking/jogging/running the 1-mile anti-bullying run with their child. If you are unable to walk/run, you can stand along the finish line to cheer on our walkers/runners. If you are attending, please arrive before 2:00pm. If you can wait outside by doors #2 or #3 in the back by the kin lab, we will be releasing students from those doors.

Please note that after the Run/Walk event, we asked that parents not check their child out. We still have the PUMPKIN DROP event that we would like all students/families to stay and observe their hard work. Please wear orange on event day as orange is the adopted color for anti-bullying month. Thanks.
