- Minor and Major clinic attendees will work on pitching mechanics and motions
- Players are split in to small groups to get extra repetitions and attention

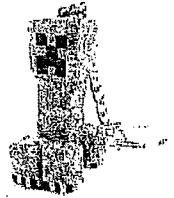

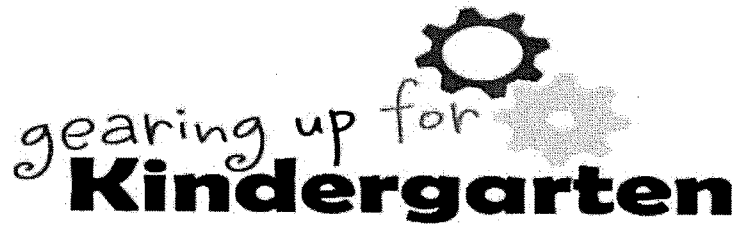
