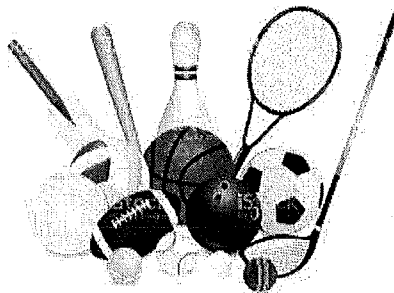
The SEA PTA invites you to the 6th Annual SEA Dance Party at Sandburg Learning Center.

so dress in your favorite uniform or jersey!

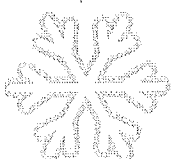
SEA students, their families and SEA staff are welcome to dance their hearts out

There will be treats, beverages and glow items available for purchase.

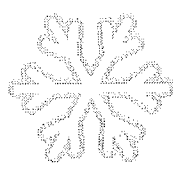
New this year, a SENSORY FRIENDLY area will be available during the dance.

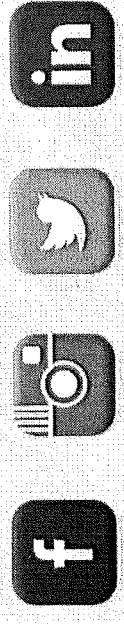

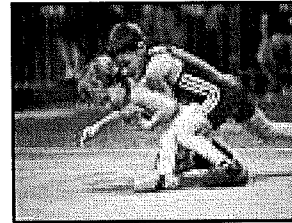
Robbinsdale Area Youth Wrestling Club
