**Registration for 2017 Season**

All boys and girls ages 7-12, living or going to school in Robbinsdale or North Minneapolis are eligible to play for Robbinsdale Little League. Registration Fees include: Complete uniform (jersey, hat, pants and socks), equipment, coaches training, and umpire costs. You will need to provide: Baseball glove and baseball cleats. To determine your baseball age, use your age as of April 30, 2017. (Little League Age Calculator: <http://www.robinsdalelittleleague.com/page/show/2331469-for-the-parents>)

**B Minor (7-8 Year olds)** Registration fee is \$105 (+ *refundable* \$100 fundraising deposit and \$150 volunteer deposits)

**A-Minor (9-12 year olds)** Registration fee, \$130 (+ *refundable* \$100 fundraising deposit and \$150 volunteer deposits)

**Majors (10-12 year olds)** Registration fee, \$155 (+ *refundable* \$100 fundraising deposit and \$150 volunteer deposits)

Players will not receive full uniform until registration is complete and paid, and Fundraising and Volunteer deposit checks have been received by Treasurer.

**Mandatory Tryouts: Tryouts will be held for A-minor players and players trying out for Majors for the first time.**

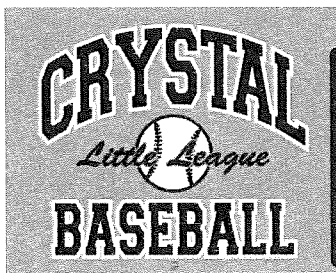
